2ND SUNDAY OF EPIPHANY

Recognising Jesus

Reading John 1: 43—end

Here we have Jesus calling two disciples, Philip and Nathaniel. Philip recognises who Jesus is straight away as being the one the prophets and Moses foretold and steps out in faith. But Nathaniel, clouded by his

prejudice that “nothing good can ever come out of Nazareth” needs more persuading and so Jesus has to show him a small miracle before he recognises and follows the Messiah.

How often do you let your prejudices and

preconceived ideas about people, based on where they’re from, or what they look like, get in the way of seeing who they really are?

Do you have to wait until Jesus shows us something “miraculous” before you follow him or can you be more like Philip, willing to step out in Faith when you recognise Jesus at work in your life?

Reading Revelations 5: 1 – 10

Here in John's great and mysterious vision of the scroll of the future we see Jesus recognised as both king and saviour, both Lion and Lamb.

The Lion of Judah, from the house of David... therefore the King of Israelites,

The Lamb that was slain...therefore the saviour of humanity

Jesus is recognised as the one who has made the ultimate sacrifice and paid the price for the sins of humanity, therefore the only one in history who is worthy to hold and open the scroll of the future.

Do you recognise this Saviour Jesus?

Do you trust him as the one worthy to hold your life and future in his hands?

If you do recognise this, how does it change what you do?
